Course Rules

This program is taught at the Berwick, Churchill and Mt Helen campuses, with the option to complete online studies.

Students must complete all the core compulsory courses within the program structure over 4 years (or part-time equivalent). Each course is usually worth 15 credit points.

A total of 480 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the program requirements of Initial Teacher Education (ITE) programs, as well as a minimum of 110 days professional experience.

You will also be required to successfully complete external Literacy and Numeracy tests prior to registration as a teacher. Please note that International Students are not eligible to study this program online.

Students will need to apply for a Working With Children (WWCC) card before commencing their program. A copy of the WWCC card must be supplied to the University prior to commencing professional experience placements, more information can be found at the WWCC website.

Co-requisite (CoR): A unit or units that must be completed concurrently with the chosen unit

Pre-requisite (PR): A unit or units that must be completed prior to undertaking another unit

Exclusion(s) (EX): A unit that is the equivalent to another unit & so excludes students from repeating an

equivalent unit

Introductory (Intro): Units that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level units

Intermediate (Inter.): Units that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level units

Advanced (Adv.): Units that are coded 3000 – 3999, advanced-level units

Major/Minor: The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree

Semester: Designated teaching period

CR: Credit Point value
