# **Competition: Respect Week Art Competition**

#### **Guidelines:**

Students are invited to submit an original artwork, (in the form of a photograph of the artwork) to equity@federation.edu.au focusing upon the theme of "What does respect mean to you?" Original artworks can be in mediums including a drawing, painting, digital art, photo, sculpture, metalwork, woodwork, poem, or poster. Submissions must also include a description (max. 200 words) of their original artwork connecting it to the theme.

## Terms & Conditions of Entry:

Every current Federation University student who completes the Respect Week Art Competition will be included in the prize draw where a student winner will win a \$250 Prezzee e-card, which can be redeemed from a variety of retailers via prezzee.com.au.)

## **FEDERATION UNIVERSITY PRIZE DRAW TERMS & CONDITIONS**

By entering the Respect Week Art Competition ("the Competition"), you ("the Entrant") agree to the following Terms and Conditions:

- 1. The Promoter is Federation University (also known as FedUni) (ABN 51 818 692 256 | CRICOS provider number 00103D | RTO code 4909 | TEQSA PRV12151 Australian University) PO Box 663 Ballarat VIC 3353.
- 2. The Competition commences on 11 March 2025 at 12.00pm and ends on 27 March at 11.59pm ("The Competition Period").
- 3. The Promoter will select one student entrant ("Winner") from those who have submitted an artwork as per the Competition Guidelines located on Federation University Respect Week webpage before that date.
- 4. The winner will be announced by 4.00pm AEST on 28 March at Federation University, Mt Helen Campus.
- 5. The name of the winner will be published both on the Federation University's Current Student Facebook and Instagram Pages and in the weekly newsletter.
- 6. The Promoter will contact the Winner by telephone and email their FedUni student email to confirm the Entrant's winning entry before 3 April 2025.
- 7. Winner will be emailed their electronic gift card to their FedUni email address shortly after 3 April 2025.
- 8. Prize must be claimed by COB 17 April 2025.
- 9. Federation University reserves the rights, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition at any time without notice.

## By entering into the Competition,

- 1. Entrants acknowledge and agree that the Promoter will collect the Entrant's personal information, including the Entrant's name, likeness, email address and social media account details which it will keep in accordance with the FedUni privacy policy, located at https://federation.edu.au/staff/governance/legal/legal-compliance/privacy
- 2. Entrants agree to receive information and marketing communications from FedUni.



- 3. Entrants grant FedUni a perpetual, irrevocable, royalty-free, fee-free, worldwide, non-exclusive license (including a right of sublicense) to reproduce, adapt, publish, perform in public, broadcast, and communicate in public the submitted artwork and its content in all media forms for marketing purposes or for any other purpose.
- 4. Entrants warrant that their submitted artwork is original work and does not infringe the rights, including but not limited to intellectual property rights or moral rights, of any third-party.
- 5. Entrants warrant they have received all required consent for the artwork filming and display of the content of their submitted artwork. This consent includes, but is not limited to, the privacy rights of individuals contained within the artwork.
- 6. Entrants warrant that they did not breach any laws in the making of their artwork, and that the display of the likewise does not breach any laws. This warranty includes, but is not limited to, the laws of trespass and the laws of defamation.
- 7. FedUni may disqualify any submitted artwork that it considers, at its absolute discretion, to be offensive or inappropriate.
- 8. Submission of an artwork with offensive or illegal content may result in disciplinary action under the relevant FedUni policy or procedure, and the notification of appropriate legal authorities.
- 9. FedUni reserve the right to retain the submitted artwork after the judging of the competition at FedUni's discretion.
- 10. In the event that the Entrant is the winner of the Competition, the Entrant may be requested to attend a photo session with FedUni, and consent to the disclosure, publication and dissemination of their name, likeness, image, and voices for the purposes of the Competition, and FedUni's advertising and marketing purposes (as winner of the Competition) for an unlimited period without remuneration. The winner may choose to opt out of participating in the photo session.
- 11. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any entries not received for any reason during the Competition Period. No responsibility will be taken for lost, late or misdirected entries
- 12. The Promoter is not responsible for technical difficulties with the entry mechanism and does not warrant that the entry mechanism will be available at all times.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

- 13. Entry is open to all current students of Federation University who submit an artwork via photo to <a href="mailto:equity@federation.edu.au">equity@federation.edu.au</a> before 11.59pm on 27 March 2025 and fully complete the competition guidelines on [https://bit.ly/4iDNPob] before that date.
- 14. Entrants may enter in the Competition once only.
- 15. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any entries not received during the Competition Period. No responsibility will be taken for lost, late or misdirected entries. The Promoter is not responsible for technical difficulties with the entry mechanism and does not warrant that the entry mechanism will be available at all times.

## Indemnity

16. FedUni is not liable for any loss, damage or injury of any nature whatsoever (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) which is suffered or sustained as a result of or in connection with creating the artwork or otherwise entering this competition.

By entering into this competition the prize winner indemnifies FedUni and waives and releases any right to all legal claims, suits and demand they may have against FedUni and its officers, directors, employees, and agents in respect of their involvement or participation in the competition. This indemnification, waiver and release includes claims caused by negligence.

18. There is one prize to be won: one \$250 Prezzee voucher. The prize is not transferable or exchangeable.

#### **DECISION FINAL**

- 19. Entrants are required to submit an original artwork, (in the form of a photograph of the artwork) to <a href="mailto:equity@federation.edu.au">equity@federation.edu.au</a> focusing upon the theme of "What does respect mean to you?" Original artworks can be in mediums including a drawing, painting, digital art, photo, sculpture, metalwork, woodwork, poem, or poster. Submissions must also include a description (max. 200 words) of their original artwork connecting it to the theme. The winner will be selected by a panel of representatives of the Promoter who, at their discretion, will select the best artwork based upon originality, creativity, and adherence to the guidelines on <a href="https://bit.ly/4iDNPob">https://bit.ly/4iDNPob</a>. Chance plays no part in determining the winners.
- 20. In relation to the Competition, all decisions of the Promoter will be final.
