### Course Requirements

Students must complete all the core compulsory units within the course structure over 4 years (or part-time equivalent).

Students will also be required to complete a total of **twelve discipline elective units** across **two areas of study**. Students also complete **two Curriculum units** in each Major study area for a total for four (see below).

Each unit is usually worth 15 credit points, except VASAP 3005 and VASAP3016.

A total of 480 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the course requirements of Initial Teacher Education (ITE) course, as well as a minimum of 80 days professional experience. You will also be required to successfully complete external Literacy and Numeracy tests prior to registration as a teacher.

Please note that International Students are not eligible to study this course online.

Students will need to apply for a Working with Children Check (WWCC) card before commencing their course. A copy of the WWCC card must be supplied to the University prior to commencing professional experience placements. More information can be found at the WWCC website.

### Major Discipline Electives

It is a requirement that Pre-Service Teachers (PSTs) complete:

- Two Major Studies of six discipline elective units each (for a total of 12 units) from two discipline sequence/study areas  
*plus*
- Two Curriculum units in each Major area of study (for a total of 4 units)

**PLEASE NOTE:** Physical Education and Outdoor Education cannot be chosen together (students wanting this combination would do this via the Badged Stream and have health as an additional discipline).
