

STATUTE 2.9 – STUDENT SENATE

1. The University shall establish a Student Senate being a democratically elected student representative body with its membership and terms of reference as ratified by the Student Senate from time to time.
2. The functions and purposes of the Student Senate include the following:
 - (1) To advise and make recommendations to the Vice-Chancellor concerning the student experience, including:
 - (a) Student amenities and services;
 - (b) University policies in relation to student life (including for students studying on-campus, at partner provider locations, online and via distance education); and
 - (c) The University's physical, cultural and technological learning environments.
 - (2) To be concerned with the improvement of the student experience for all students of the University.
 - (3) To provide avenues for all students to give feedback and make recommendations to the Student Senate.
3.
 - (1) The Council may at any time make Regulations, not inconsistent with this Statute, prescribing all matters which by this Statute are required or permitted to be prescribed, or which are necessary or convenient to be prescribed for carrying out or giving effect to this Statute and by later Regulation revoke or amend any such Regulations.
 - (2) Regulations made under this Statute shall be promulgated by being exhibited on the official notice boards of the University and after being so promulgated shall remain so exhibited for at least fourteen days during which time the University is operating.
