

The 2019 Vice-Chancellor's Learning and Teaching Awards were presented on Thursday 7 November 2019 at the Berwick campus as part of the 9th Annual Learning and Teaching Showcase. From a pool of eight applications, two staff members were assessed by a panel of senior leaders, peers, and students as providing sustained and outstanding contributions to student learning experiences at Federation University.

Dr. Megan Jenkins received her award for providing real-world experiences to psychology student. The panel commented that Dr. Jenkins demonstrated 'passion', 'self-awareness', and 'innovation' which resulted in evidence-based and 'measurably higher student success' outcomes.

Dr. Renee Paulet received her award for implementing peer-review evaluations of blended teaching in the Federation Business School. The panel commented that Dr. Paulet demonstrated 'sustained interest', a "positive impact", and shared teaching and learning success', to 'inform changes to teaching practices' for the 'benefit of the university'
