We are sorry to inform you that your Federation University graduation ceremony has been postponed in line with Australian Government restrictions on mass gatherings as part of the national response to coronavirus COVID 19.

All graduation ceremonies due to be held in March/April 2020 will be rescheduled to the end of the year. Given the unusual circumstances, we will refund your graduation event fee and will initiate a new registration and payment process once the revised date is confirmed. We are working with our graduation service provider to organise this refund and will endeavour to complete this process as swiftly as possible.

Our graduation ceremonies are a formal event to celebrate your achievements with family and friends and we hope you are able to join us to mark this occasion later in the year. Postponing the event does not impact the completion of your degree. You are now a graduate of Federation University regardless of when you attend a graduation ceremony.
