As we have previously advised, Federation University is transitioning to online delivery from Monday 30 March in line with government measures to combat the spread of COVID-19.

We understand you may be feeling anxious about transitioning to online learning and would like to reassure you of our support for you during this time.

To ensure you are not impacted financially or experience unnecessary anxiety, Federation University has determined that where students engage with their studies **any course fails this semester will incur no academic penalty** and will not appear on student transcripts.

Further to this, **international students will not be required to pay fees for repeating these courses as the result of failure in this semester.**

We would like to reassure you the university is well prepared for the provision of online learning and has many years of experience with online delivery. Whilst the nature of your study will be different, we are confident that you will find your studies rewarding.
