Funding research has rarely been easy however the funding landscape in Australia has changed in many ways in recent years. Government funding has

declined and is more targeted than ever. New research funding arrangements encourage interaction with industry but Australian industry's collaboration with universities for R&D lags behind other OECD countries. This landscape has led Australian researchers to adopt a variety of attitudes to funding. These range from designing projects that require minimal resources to spending large tracts of research time preparing submissions and building relationships that might lead to grants. Universities have sought to encourage and direct diverse models in different ways in response to these changes.

This forum is presented by a panel of FOST researchers that represent different approaches to research funding. The forum is intended to appeal to ECR and MCR research active staff and later year HDR students who are determining their own approach to funding
