

Federation Business School Applied Degree Entrance Requirements & Credit Arrangements

The following rules apply to student entry requirements and credit granted into the Bachelor of Applied Management (BAM) and the Bachelor of Hospitality Management (BOHM).

This policy requires that the credit application be submitted with enrolment documentation.

*NOTE: Enrolment into the program does not guarantee provision of credit, or the amount of credit provided. Credit will be provided once credit applications are processed.

International Advanced Diplomas must be approved by Federation Business School; Plus documented work place experience (Portfolio of evidence required). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Note: RPL of 30%, or greater, within any qualification used for credit, may negate credit for workplace experience. In this instance, credit for work experience is considered as already recognised and included as part of the RPL process. Total credits granted for recognized Diploma, Advanced Diploma, and Workplace Experience is 240. This credit allows entry into year three 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Credit will be provided for a recognized Vocational Advanced Diploma in any discipline with a minimum of six (6) business/management units, in at least four (4) discipline areas is required. 50% of the three year Bachelor's Degree is credited, 180 credit points granted, for Advanced Diplomas with 1.5 – 2 years volume of learning, as per AQF recommendations. International Advanced Diplomas must be approved by Federation Business School and satisfy AQF equivalence. Plus documented work place experience (Portfolio of evidence required). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Note: RPL of 30%, or greater, within any qualification used for credit, may negate credit for workplace experience. In this instance, credit for work experience is considered as already recognised and included as part of the RPL process. Total credits granted for recognized Advanced Diploma (with 1.5 – 2 years volume of learning) and Workplace Experience is 240. This credit allows entry into year three. Advanced Diplomas with less than the 1.5 – 2 years volume of learning will require students to complete four (4) year two BAM subjects before undertaking year three.
