

Honours Equivalence for Nominated Federation University Programs

Federation University postgraduate programs by coursework which include a research component may meet the requirements for honours equivalence. Subject to satisfactory completion of required courses, graduates of these programs are deemed to meet honours equivalence and are therefore eligible for an offer of probationary candidature in a Higher Degree by Research program. This form enables Faculties to seek approval for recognition of honours equivalence for nominated FedUni programs.

Graduates of these programs must meet entry requirements for honours equivalence as follows:

Entry to PhD: Equivalence to H2A or above with an average score in **identified courses** of 70% or more (GPA 6, Distinction average).

Entry to Masters: Equivalence to H2B or above with an average score in identified courses of 60% or more (GPA 5, Credit average)
