



## Dyson Airblades Installed

Dyson Airblades are now installed in the Unisports change rooms and the Library toilets at Mt Helen campus.

Each toilet was using 2 hand towel rolls per day which is expensive, labour intensive and creates waste to landfill.

The Airblades cost \$ 999 each so their return on investment is less than 3 months. We will monitor the performance and feedback of these units and hopefully roll out more.



## Water Fountains Installed

Students just love the new water fountains installed at Mt Helen, SMB, Camp St and Horsham campuses.

We're hoping to install water meters on the fountains so we can measure their consumption. We'll also monitor the consumption of purchased bottled water to see if the fountains are impacting bottled water sales.



## Greener Government Buildings Update

Expect to see Siemens contractors around our campuses over the next 4 months. Siemens are analysing energy and water performance on buildings at SMB, Camp St, Mt Helen, Horsham, Stawell and Ararat campuses. Their Detailed Facility Study report will be submitted to the University in June 2013.

## Fair Trade Tea & Coffee
