STRATEGIC MATTERS

Social Inclusion Plan 2015-2016 Final Update and Report

Mr Darren Holland, Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Student Support and Services provided Council with an update in relation to the Social Inclusion Plan and highlighted the following points:

- the Plan establishes objectives, actions and indicators, and provides a coordinated framework for on-going improvement, with respect to equity, diversity and social inclusion, in all aspects of FedUni's operations;
- the final update at the end of 2016 outlines a range of achievements across the three priority areas, which include
 - Priority 1 Aspiration and Access
 - o Priority 2 Participation and Attainment
 - Priority 3 Social Inclusion and Culture
- the Plan outlines a coordinated approach and includes references to the Reconciliation Action Plan, Disability Action Plan and BOLD Learning and Teaching Plan;
- the development and implementation of the Plan is overseen and monitored by FedUni's Social Inclusion Committee and supported by the Equity and Equal Opportunity Office; and
- the Plan is still relevant for 2017.
