



Coronavirus response - Federation University Australia

Dear Student,

In light of the recent surge in COVID-19 cases across Victoria, the University has reassessed on campus activity, and reviewed the protocols around student attendance. The University's COVID-19 Transition Control Group has determined those working in a private sector (ie non-public) aged care service in the 14 days preceding a scheduled on-campus practical class must not attend campus to undertake the scheduled activity. This will take effect from this coming Monday, 3 August 2020.

If you work in a private aged care facility in the 14 days prior to your practical class, do not come on campus.

Instead, please advise your Course Coordinator via email so they are aware that you require alternate arrangements – their contact details are available within [Moodle](#). You will not be penalised for this; your class will be rescheduled to a later time when the pandemic situation in Victoria allows.

We thank you for your understanding and your commitment to keeping Victoria safe.
