

### **Coronavirus response - Federation University Australia**

Dear Student,

We need to provide clarification regarding the face mask rules in classrooms and trade training and update you on COVID-19 public exposure sites in Victoria.

## Face mask rules in classrooms and trade training

Last week, we advised you that face masks were not required in classrooms or trade training environments.

We now need to change this and advise that you <u>must wear face masks in class</u> and trade training environments in TAFE and higher education.

The advice last week was given based on the advice for all schools, school staff and workplaces. However, the Department of Education and Training has sent advice this week to all adult education institutions advising that classrooms and trade training environments are considered public spaces – so face masks must continue to be worn by students (where safe to do so).

Staff do not need to wear a mask while teaching in these spaces but must put it back on when not engaged in teaching activities.

Face masks must be worn in all clinical settings such as medical centres and while engaged in nursing and health discipline practicals.

We apologise for any confusion this may have caused.

## New exposure sites in Victoria

Due the significant outbreak of COVID-19 in New South Wales, new positive cases have been recorded in Victoria in the past 24 hours, due to people travelling from NSW to VIC. There are new exposures sites listed at coronavirus.vic.gov.au/exposure-sites.

**Ballan exposure site:** Ballan Mobil Service Centre has been listed as an exposure site on 8 July between 5:00 – 7:00pm. This service centre is a regular stop for many people travelling between Western Victoria (including Ballarat) and Melbourne.

There are also exposure sites listed in Craigieburn, Maribyrnong and Broadmeadows.

If you were at an exposure site at the times listed on the website, there are testing and home quarantine requirements. If you are personally impacted by these, please speak to your course coordinator or teaching team so we can help you with alternative arrangements due to any home quarantine period.

You will not be penalised for following the home quarantine requirements of Victorian authorities.

Please check the public exposure sites regularly on the <u>Victorian Government</u> Coronavirus website.

## Home quarantine for anyone returning from New South Wales

As of Monday, all of New South Wales became a "red zone" for people travelling from NSW to VIC. Greater Sydney was already a "red zone".

This means anyone who has travelled from NSW into Victoria since Monday must get tested for COVID-19 and isolate at home for 14 days (even if they return a negative test result).
