

Terms and Conditions:

Vice-Chancellors Award

Federation University offers a limited number of Vice-Chancellors Awards to recognise and support outstanding academic achievers from designated regions. These scholarships aim to reward academic excellence and foster leadership and community engagement within the University environment.

Eligibility

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must meet all the following criteria:

- Be enrolling as a commencing international student in 2026 who is a citizen of one of the following regions:
 - South Asia
 - Southeast Asia
 - China
- Have achieved an average mark of 90% or equivalent in prior studies that are the basis of admission. *Federation University reserves the right to assess and determine the equivalency and validity of all academic results and GPA calculations in accordance with its own grading and admissions framework.*
- Eligible to study in Australia with a valid visa.
- Submit a separate scholarship application and participate in an interview process.
- Meet the additional terms and conditions as set out below.

Application and Selection

A separate scholarship application is required and must be submitted by the published deadline.

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to participate in an interview as part of the assessment process.

The scholarship is awarded based on academic excellence, leadership qualities, and the applicant's potential to positively contribute to the Federation University community.

Terms and Conditions

1. Applicants and awardees must be enrolled in a Federation University undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree.
2. The Vice-Chancellors Award covers 50% of the tuition fees and is initially awarded for a period of two semesters. Continuation of the scholarship beyond this period is subject to academic performance and ongoing eligibility as outlined below.
3. The scholarship will be calculated on the full tuition fee for each unit and will be calculated based on the number of units enrolled in, during each semester.
4. To continue receiving the scholarship into the third and future semesters, awardees must maintain a GPA of 6.5 or higher. *Federation University reserves the right to assess and determine the equivalency and validity of all academic results and GPA calculations in accordance with its own grading and admissions framework.*
5. If an awardee is approved compassionate or compelling leave from studies for a semester, the scholarship will be reinstated on their return to study.
6. The scholarship is non-refundable and may not be transferred to a cash amount.
7. If an awardee withdraws from the course, they will forfeit the scholarship.
8. The scholarship cannot be deferred for commencement in a future calendar year.
9. If a student loses eligibility for the scholarship in their third or any subsequent semester, they will not be reconsidered for the scholarship in the future.
10. Federation University reserves the right to assess and determine the equivalency and validity of all academic results and GPA calculations in accordance with its own grading and admissions framework.

Scholarship Offer

One (1) scholarship will be awarded per region (South Asia, Southeast Asia, and China), per semester (March and July and November) intake (a maximum of (3) scholarships will be awarded per region per academic year).

Retention Requirements

To maintain the scholarship in the third and subsequent semesters of study, recipients must:

- Maintain an GPA of 6.5 or higher.
- Remain enrolled full-time in an eligible program at Federation University.
- Continue to hold a valid visa for study in Australia.
- Comply with all University policies and student conduct requirements.
- Scholarship retention will be assessed after two semesters. If you are re-awarded the scholarship, it will be valid for an additional two semesters.
- Failure to meet any of the above retention conditions may result in the scholarship being withdrawn.

General Conditions

Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the University and are subject to availability.

The University regards any decision in relation to these scholarships as final and will not entertain any appeal.

The University reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time.
