#### • University's Five Year Plan

Development on this has already started with the Deans and International Partners Committee. Todd attached a copy of one of the priorities in the email, which is Strategy 1.1 in the university's five year plan: *Continuing to internationalise the curriculum to prepare FedUni students to be global citizens.* The IoC Working Party has been asked to flesh out how this strategy could be implemented and provide this feedback to Todd within the next 2 months. Todd indicated that he would be happy to attend an IOC Working Party meeting to discuss further.
