Arts - English/Literature, Media and Screen Studies, Indigenous Studies, History, Philosophy, Sociology and Writing – see below for course offerings

Welfare and Behavioural Sciences - Community & Human Services and Behavioural Studies – see below for course offerings

Language Studies – Japanese (available at Federation University) – see below for course offerings; Indonesian, Chinese, French, German (available external to Federation University via Regional Universities Network (RUN)).

4. **30 credit points (two courses) of School Electives taken from other courses offered within the School of Arts;**

5. **60 credit points (four courses) of ELECTIVES taken from any recognized courses offered by the University.**

Note: If a student has chosen courses that are equal to, or more than, 150 credit points outside the School in the 2. Major (90 credit points) and 3. Minor (60 Credit Points), the student needs to select all 60 credit points of electives from within the School of Arts.

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Glossary

Semester – designated teaching period

Pre-requisite (PR) – a course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course

Co-requisite (CoR) – a course or courses that must be completed concurrently with the chosen course

Exclusion (EX) – a course that is the equivalent to another course and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent course

Major/Minor – the main subject area of study completed as part of a degree

Introductory Level (Intro) – Courses that are coded 1000 - 1999

Intermediate Level (Inter.) – Courses that are coded 2000 – 2999

Advanced Level (Adv.) – Courses that are coded 3000 – 3999

CR – Credit point value

MTH – Mt Helen campus offering location

ODL – Online offering location
