### Additional Information

This program structure applies to students commencing their TC5 Bachelor of Education Studies (Program P) program.

- You must complete all core compulsory courses within the program structure over 3 years (or part-time equivalent), unless you are eligible to transfer into the pathway entry program\* (see below).
- You will also be required to complete six discipline elective courses in two areas of study. One will be a minor study (4 course sequence) and one will be a part study (2 course sequence).
- Each course is usually 15 credit points.
- A total of 360 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the program requirements.

Note: If you wish to apply for course credits, please contact your Program Leader or Student HQ.

If you are unable to, or are having difficulties enrolling in *myStudentCentre*, please contact Student HQ.

*\*Successful completion of at least one year of the TC5 program may qualify (pending School approval) interested students for transfer into TZ5 Bachelor of Education (Primary). Once eligibility has been assessed, students can then apply for credit transfer.*

## Glossary

**Semester** – designated teaching period

**Co-requisite (CoR)** – a selection of courses that need to be completed at the same time

**Pre-requisite (PR)** – a course or courses that must be completed prior to undertaking another course

**CR** – Credit Points

**Exclusion (EX)** – a course that is the equivalent to another course and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent course

**Major/Minor** – the main subject area of study completed as part of a degree

**Level** (ie first, second, third) – introductory, intermediate and advanced level courses

**BER** - Berwick

**CHLL** – Churchill

**FLXK** – Flexible Delivery Berwick

**ODL** – Online

**BKIM** – Kangan Institute (Broadmeadows)
