What is HDR?

Higher Degree by Research – HDR

 defined under the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) as a program where the assessable content by research represents more than two-thirds of the total assessable content.

- Research Doctorate (PhD)
 - 3 years
 - AQF 10
- Research Masters (MSc, MEngSc, MA, MBus)
 - 1.5 years
 - AQF 9



Entry Requirements and Pathways

Entry requirements:

 Honours degree: 12 month research project, with evidence of a substantial thesis, exegesis, creative works, along with skills in literature review methodology.

Or

- 'Equivalence' to an Australian Homological at AQF 8 with a substantial research component including a thesis of at least 12000 words as an addition to an undergraduate degree at AQF 7.
 - This might be a Masters by coursework degree with a substantial research project component.
- We also offer a Graduate Certificate in Research & Date way, for those that have accumulated relevant industry experience, and/or meet partial requirements.
 - 1 semester full-time. Part time also available. Online, or on campus.

Did you know? (2021 information).

- 42% of all Federation HDR candidates are industry connected.
- They are engaged joint supervision, co-funde projects or internships.
 - National average is 14%
 - Federation was aiming for 50%.
- Over 60% of scholarship's awarded are now industry funded or co-

funded (2023 information).



Co-operative Experiential Learning and HDR

1. Co-Design

We work with industry and the community to co-design research projects.

2. Co-supervise

Industry experienced experts co-supervise our students.



Co-operative Experiential Learning and HDR

3. Co-fund

Industry invest in research projects through scholarships, operating costs, and provision of in-kind support (data, staff time etc).

4. <u>Internships</u>

Our HDR candidates spend time working with a research end-user. They will spend a minimum of 3 months (60 FTE days) working, but have considerable flexibility in the way this is implemented.



Skills Development Program

- The HDR Skills Development Program (SDP) supports our PhD and Masters by Research candidates to timely completion.

Institutional Partnerships - HDR

1. Joint supervision:

- Federation principal and associate supervisors; international co-supervisors
- Can be reciprocal where Federation co-supervise your students.

2. Designated Cohort:

 Where the University may choose to accept a cohort of candidates, subject to special support arrangements and conditions.



Institutional Partnerships - HDR

3. Cotutelle

 Candidate is enrolled in two institutions, and by meeting the requirements of both institutions would graduate with two individual testamurs.

4. Joint Award

 Candidate is enrolled in two institutions, and by meeting the requirements of both institutions would graduate with one testamur.
